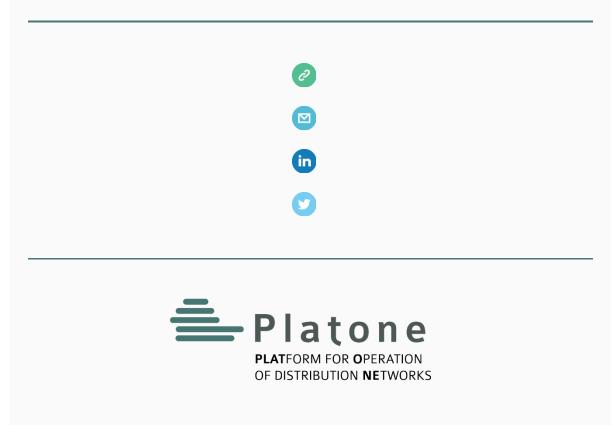
How Platone results gain impact in the Linux Energy Foundation
